Happenings in the Village 2016

1. The excessive heat this summer resulted in limited work in the village. Potential volunteers were not called due to these conditions. Dick Waters, John Austin, and Don Allen tried to keep up with general maintenance.
2. There were 28 weddings in the church and one Hospice service.
3. The village buildings were open the 4th of July, for two of the Food Truck Throw Down evenings, and the Sunday of Apple Fest.
4. Our school tours had over 400 students and chaperones in the village this fall.
5. We now have two working forges in the blacksmith shop which are vented to the outside.
6. The blacksmith shop has new electrical wiring and lights.
7. Due to the growth of the village, the primary power system will be upgraded next spring.
